



Dr. Alice P. Green Institute for Racial Justice seeks an undergraduate student for the Internship program for Fall 2026. This paid internship program, held in-person at the Center for Law and Justice at Albany, NY, and the M.E Grenander Department of Special Collections and Archives at the University at Albany, as well as remotely, provides professional experience in original research, oral history, digital humanities and social media.

The student selected will work under the guidance of APGI leadership who will provide mentorship and guidance. The intern selected will have the opportunity to conduct original research on Black political culture in Albany, disseminate their research through social media and public presentations, and attend the events organized by Alice Moore Black Cultural Center and the Center for Law and Justice.

- A Cover Letter explaining their interest in the position and how they think their previous experience can contribute to the project.

The intern of the Dr. Alice Green Institute will explore and interpret documents and photographs held at the Dr. Alice P. Green archival collection.

Students will be responsible for:

1. Designing pertinent and accurate social media entries highlighting the historical documents of Dr. Alice P. Green's collection.
2. Generate written interviews with community members, graduate and undergraduate students selected for Dr. Alice P. Green fellowship.
3. Manage the social media of Dr. Alice P. Green Institute.
4. Respond to inquiries from applicants.
5. Under the supervision of the directors of the Dr. Alice P. Green Institute, the intern coordinates the logistics for the application workshops.
6. Under the guidance of the Directors, the interns will design a social media campaign to raise awareness of the fellowships and the Spring 2027 application process.
7. The Institute intern will participate in tabling and other events sharing information about the archives and the fellowships.
